At the same time, research on learning indicates that well-integrated assessments contribute in critical ways to successful learning outcomes through the impact they have on motivation, engagement, feedback, and depth of learning. The 2014 University of Calgary Conference on Postsecondary Learning and Teaching will provide an opportunity to share expertise on how we leverage the benefits of effective assessment practice to achieve not only more effective evaluation, but also more successful learning experiences.
